

Editor's View



Nation First for 'Karmyogi' Modi

M Narendra Modi is really a 'Karmyogi' and for him the nation is supreme. This is evident from the fact that soon after performing the last rites of his mother, Modi returned to work. When leaders of today delay funerals to wait for the VIPs to come for paying tributes, Modi gave a message that for him 'Nation is first' by attending the funeral of his mother as a commoner.

Modi's mother Heeraben Modi passed away, on December 30, 2022, at the age of 100. A stoic-looking PM performed the last rites of his mother in Gujarat's Gandhinagar and soon after performing his duties as a son, he resumed his responsibility as the 'Pradhan Sevak' of the country.

Despite the enormity of the tragedy, Modi decided to carry on with his official engagements and also directed the Union Ministers to continue with their engagements.

Within hours after he performed the last rites of his mother in Gujarat's Gandhinagar, the PM virtually attended two back-to-back meetings — flagging off the new Vande Bharat Express between Howrah and New Jalpaiguri and chairing the meeting of the National Ganga Council — through video conferencing. He also apologized to the people of Bengal for not being able to attend the program in person.

This is not the first time that Modi returned to work after enduring a personal loss. In 1989, when his father Damodardaas Modi passed away, he showed similar dedication towards his duty.

Bhartiya Janata Party (BJP) workers had assembled in Ahmedabad for a pre-scheduled meeting, which was supposed to be joined by Narendra Modi also. When the workers were informed that Narendra Modi's father has passed away and he had gone to Vadnagar, they thought he will not be able to join the meeting. However, to everyone's surprise, Modi arrived at the venue in the afternoon.

Everyone instinctually asked Modi, "why he came back to Ahmedabad to attend a party meeting despite the fact that his father passed away", he answered, "The last rites have been performed and I have returned to fulfil my duty towards the party, as I have to continue with the work."

Financial sector to undergo sea change in next fiscal

Change of guards on the cards in LIC

With the Chairman of Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) of India M R Kumar's current extended term coming to an end in March, all eyes are set on who the next Chief of the country's largest life insurer would be. Kumar appointed Chairman in 2019, received an extension in 2022 ahead of the initial public offering of the insurance behemoth.

While yet another extension to Kumar cannot be totally ruled out, the insurance circles are abuzz with rumours that Kumar's designation may be changed to MD and CEO and he may be asked to continue. There has been much progress in LIC during his tenure. There are also talks of a private sector professional or an MD and CEO of a top bank being appointed new Chairman of the LIC.

Well informed sources, however, said that the idea of appointing CEO in the LIC has been shelved till 2024. In case the Government drops the idea to have an MD & CEO, one of the present MD of LIC may step in his shoes. In such a case, Siddhartha Mohanty, who remains the senior-most with versatility in experience is seen as a strong contender to replace Kumar.







MR Kumar, Chairman LIC of India

M R Kumar, Chairman of LIC of India since March, 2019, in a career spanning more than 35 years, has had the unique privilege of heading three Zones of LIC, viz, Southern Zone, North Central Zone and Northern Zone, head quartered at Chennai, Kanpur and Delhi, respectively. Besides, he has also been Regional Manager (Marketing) and Regional Manager (P&IR) at Kolkata and

As an Executive Director he headed the Personnel Department as well as the Pension and Group Insurance vertical of the Corporation. During his tenure several initiatives were rolled out for the benefit of the employees His rich experience working pan India, including the heartland states of India while heading Kanpur Zone, gave him a deep insight into the demographics and insurance potential of the country.

Siddhartha Mohanty MD, LIC

Due to retire on June 30, 2023, Mohanty started his career with LIC in 1985 and made his mark in Marketing, HR, Investments and Legal.

Meanwhile, the Financial Services Institutions Bureau has recommended M Jagannath and Tablesh Pandey for the vacancies of MD positions LIC. Raj Kumar, the seniormost MD, retired on January 31 and B C Patnaik's term as MD will end on March 31. Jagannath and Pandey are likely to succeed Kumar and Patnaik, respectively.

Financial sector to undergo sea change in next fiscal

Four state-run banks see a change

Major state-run financial-sector players viz. Canara Bank, Bank of Baroda, Indian Overseas Bank, and Bank of India are all set to set to welcome new management in the fiscal 2023 - 24.

While Canara Bank will see replacement of L V Prabhakar, MD and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Bank, who has retired from his services on December 31,2022, on attaining the age of superannuation, MD and CEO of Indian Overseas Bank, Partha Pratim Sengupta also retired on December 31,2022. Besides, Bank of Baroda's MD and CEO Sanjiv Chadha and Bank of India's MD and CEO A K Das's, three-year term has also come to an end in January 2023 though both will, however, turn 60 in June. Chadha's term has however been extended for a period till the date of his superannuation i.e. till June 30,2023.

The Financial Services Institutions Bureau (FSIB), the headhunting entity for directors of state-owned banks and financial institutions - set up as a single autonomous professional body tasked to search and recommend high-caliber persons for appointment as Whole time directors (WTDs) and non-executive Chairpersons in public sector banks, public sector insurers and financial institutions - has recommended K Satyanarayana Raju for MD & CEO of Canara Bank, AK Srivastava for MD & CEO of IOB, Debadatta Chand for MD & CEO of BoB and Rajneesh Karnatak for MD & CEO of BoI.



K Satyanarayana Raju, MD & CEO, Canara Bank
